Nathalie Aminian is an Associate Professor of Economics (**Tenured**) at the University of Rouen Normandie. She co-directs the Master's program specializing in *Financial Risk Management* (EGRF) and *Banking* (BCCPRO). Previously, she taught at Sciences Po (EU-Asia Program, 2009-2010) and University of Le Havre (1997-2012) where she served as Director of the Master's program in International Business (2000-2005). Her research focuses on global trade and finance, trade policy, innovation and clusters, the internationalization of the Yuan, the Belt and Road Initiative in the digital era, and trade relations between major economies, including U.S.-China, China-EU, and China-Latin America. She has contributed to the literature on production sharing and trade in parts and components, exchange rate policy, and digital trade strategies within formal economic models. Her work has been published in leading journals such as *Economic Change and Restructuring*, *Review of Development Economics*, *Japan and the World Economy*, *Journal of Economic Integration*, *International Journal of Services Technology and Management*, *Journal of International and Global Economic Studies*, *Journal of Chinese Economic and Business Studies*, *China Economic Policy Review* and the *Chinese Economy*. She has guest-edited special issues for the *International Journal of Services Technology and Management* (special issue of "Global Economy and the Service Sectors") and *The Chinese Economy* (special Issue on «The Chinese Economy's Comparisons and Links with Latin America»). Nathalie has organized series of international conferences in collaboration with Inha University, Korea (2007-2012) and APEA (2014 and 2020) and, has been a visiting scholar at Kyoto University (2011) and the University of Tokyo (2017). 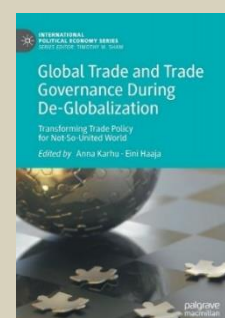
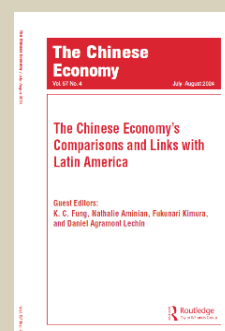
