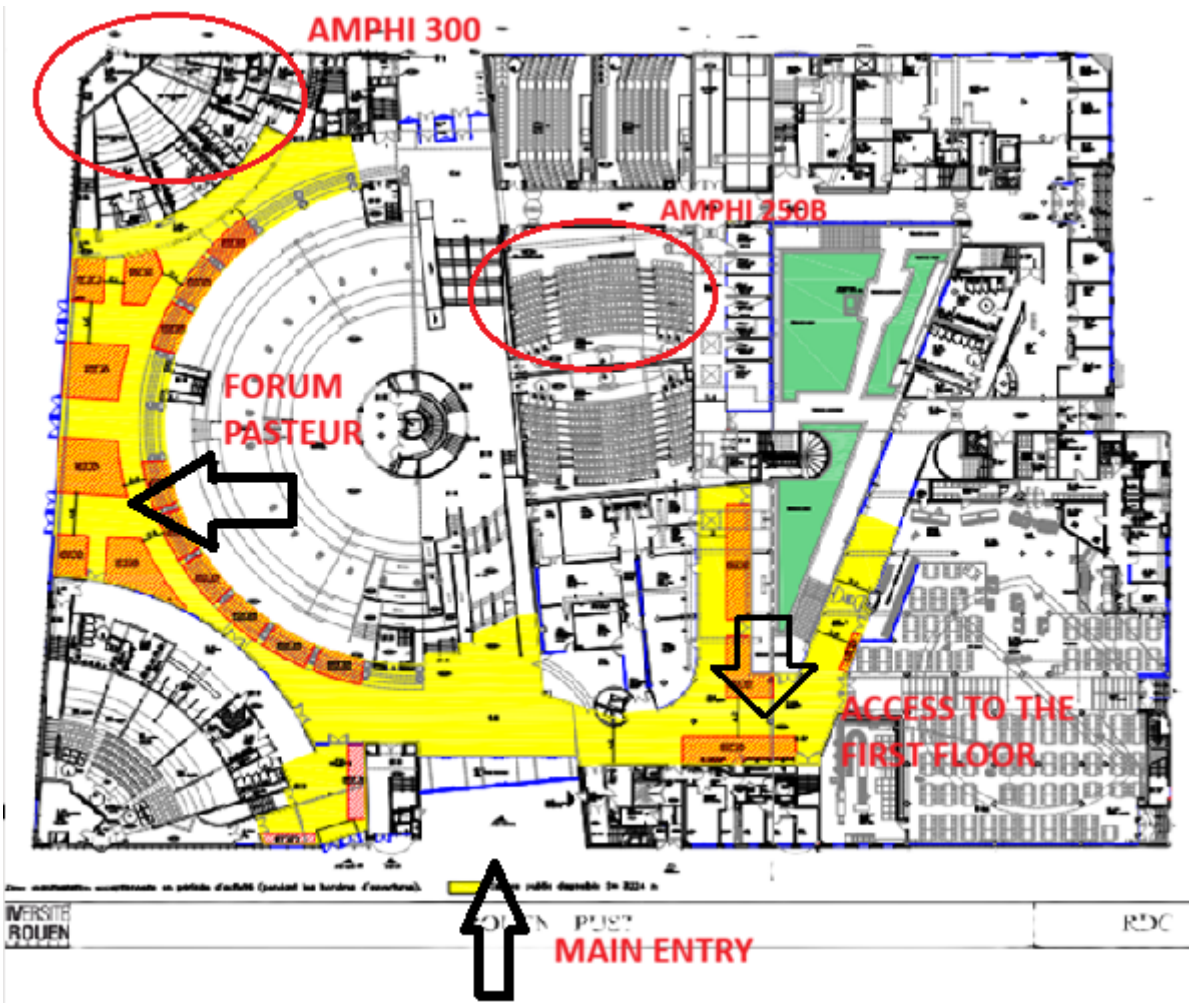

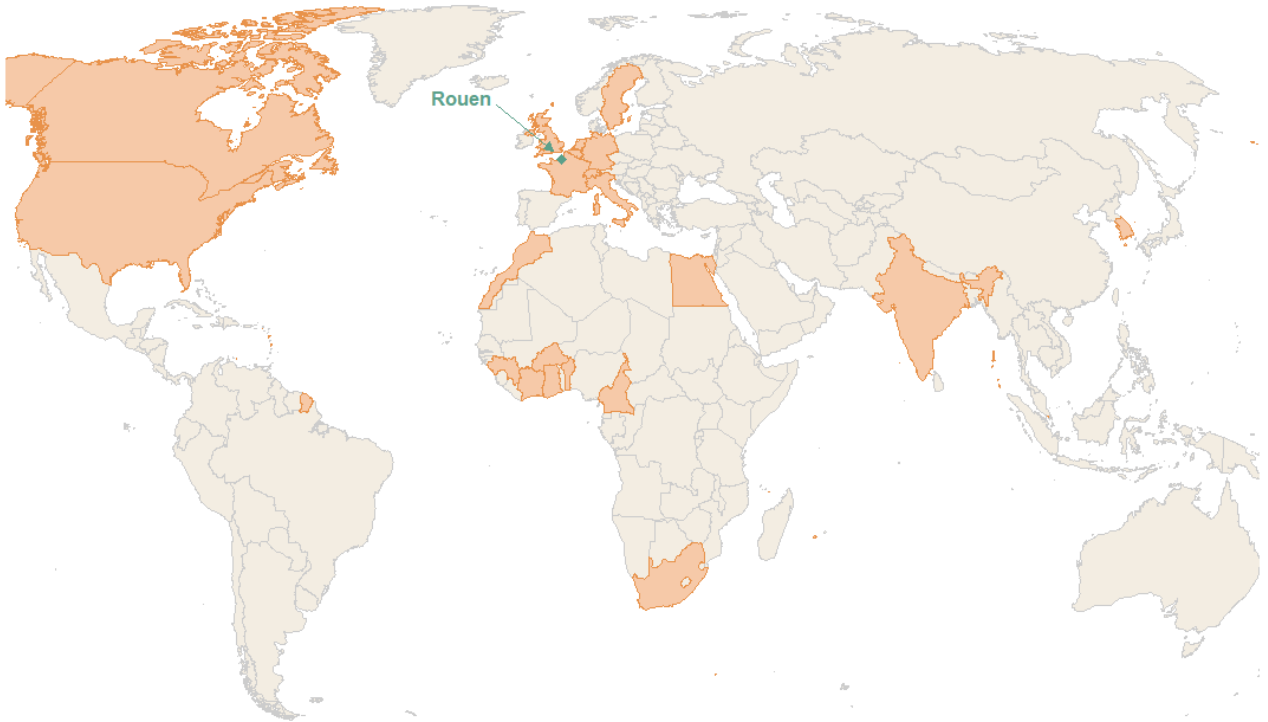
Campus map

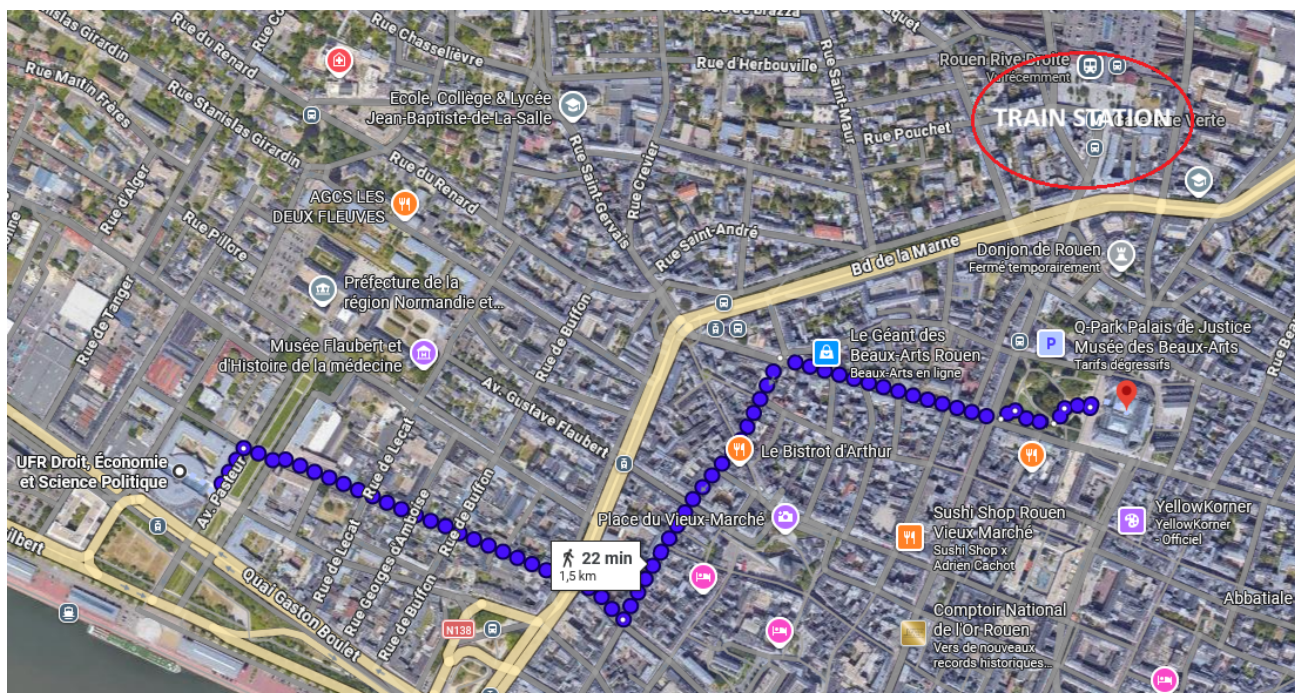

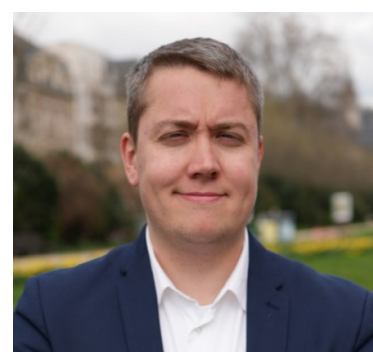
